### For Immediate Release

On January 13, 2009 at approximately 3:00 p.m. the Sauk Prairie Police Department was called to the 200 block of Monroe Street in the Village of Sauk City for a report a person who broke into a residence.

Sauk Prairie Officers arrived on scene and were told that the suspect fled on foot. Officers were able to obtain the description of the suspect and immediately relayed the information to responding officers.

According to the complainant, he heard a loud bang coming from the kitchen. The resident went to see what the noise was and as he walked into the kitchen, the resident observed a man standing in the kitchen. The suspect fled on foot.

Investigating officers were able to locate the suspect's footprints leaving the residence. Officers were able to follow the footprints to a home in the 400 block of Monroe Street in the Village of Sauk City.

As a result of the investigation, Colin Marquardt, 20 years old, Mazomanie was arrested and charged with Burglary of a Dwelling, Misdemeanor Bail Jumping and Felony Bail Jumping. Mr. Marquardt was transported and booked into the Sauk County Jail.
