### Police K-9 Sniff leads to Drug Arrest

On Monday January 17, 2011 at approximately 2:30 p.m. the Sauk Prairie Police Department responded to 115 Tower Street in the Village of Prairie du Sac to investigate the smell of burnt marijuana throughout the apartment building.

Investigating officers arrived on scene and the police department's narcotics dog, Junior and his handler performed a canine sniff of the common hallways and Junior showed a positive narcotic odor response on the door of apartment 114.

Officers made contact with the tenants in apartment 114 and the officers were given consent to search the apartment.

As a result of the investigation, Trudy Kizzire, 49, Prairie du Sac, was charged with one (1) count of maintaining a Drug Dwelling and one (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. A 16 year old male from Prairie du Sac was charged with one (1) count of Possession of Cocaine and one (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

### Traffic Stop leads to Drug Arrest

On Thursday January 13, 2011 at approximately 10:45 p.m. the Sauk Prairie Police Department stopped a vehicle at the intersection of Van Buren Street and Riviera Drive for going the wrong way on a one way street.

As the officer approached the vehicle the odor of marijuana could be smelled coming from the vehicle. The investigating officer requested the assistance of the police department's narcotics dog, Junior and his handler.

As a result of the investigation several items of contraband were turned over to the officers, including two (2) marijuana grinders, a multi colored glass pipe and a small glass jar containing plant material.

Joshua Pace, 21 from Baraboo was charged with one (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Operating after Suspension 6<sup>th</sup> Offense and was in violation of his probation. Pace was transported to the Sauk County Jail.

Marcus Bredesen, 20 from Baraboo was charged with one (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and one (1) count of Possession of Marijuana.

On January 14, 2011 at approximately 7:19 p.m. the Sauk Prairie Police Department's K-9 Unit stopped a vehicle on STH 188 near STH 60 in the Town of West Point for an equipment violation.

Upon contact with the driver of the vehicle, the officer explained the reason for the stop and that the officer was going to use his K-9 partner, Junior to perform a sniff around the vehicle. Junior showed a positive narcotic odor response on the vehicle.

The occupants were removed from the vehicle in order to perform an interior search of the car. The occupants were later transported to the Sauk Prairie Police Department for questioning.

As a result of the investigation Jacob Sprecher, 20 from Sauk City was charged with one (1) count of Possession of Marijuana, one (1) count of Possession of Cocaine and Bail Jumping.
